Rules Governing play

- Straight start, double finish on all games played. The games will be scored alternately by both sides with the home team scoring first. (Chalk and Walk)
- Games are to commence at 7.30, with a 7.45 deadline.
- Match fee: \$15.00
- Teams must be mixed. Singles must be mixed (i.e. contain at least 1 man and 1 woman, the other players may be of either gender.) At least 1 man and 1 woman must play in each of the 3 rounds of doubles.
- Each round of doubles must contain the same pairs of players. Up to 2 players may be substituted, provided that the pairs are not altered. (To Play 8 players. Any two sets of doubles may be shared by 3 players each).
- Games are to be played as per sheet unless agreed by both captains to alter the order of games.
- Averages will be taken on all singles games. Short averages are to be taken and recorded on the match sheet by the home team. Players must have averages on 5 matches to be graded for GLDA Championships.
- Each team may register up to 9 players, with a player being able to register with only one nominated registered team. each team may field only 8 players on any one night. The fee for registration is \$7.00 per player. A player may register and play on the night, provided that his/her registration fee accompanies the game sheet.
- A player must have played a minimum of FOUR SINGLES matches in the fixture with the qualifying team to play in any semi, final or grand final.
- Any team forfeiting must submit playing fees for both teams. Both teams should submit a sheet through the normal channels.
- Game sheets must be handed to the Recorder/ Secretary, or dropped off at 122 Kularoo drive, or left in the box provided at FTMSC by 7.00pm of the Thursday following the match. Late lodgement of sheets (including average sheets) will incur a fine of \$15.00. Incorrect game sheet will incur a fine of \$15.00.
- Full names of players to be used or Initial and name or name and initial will be accepted.
- Failure to have a captain or delegate attend a meeting will incur a \$15.00 fine.
- Any team or player who owes money to the associations not eligible to play until this money is paid. Any fines imposed, if
 not already paid, may be enclosed with playing fees of the following match. If the fine has not been paid, all games played by
 that player/team will be forfeited.
- Any complaint should be submitted in writing to the secretary.
